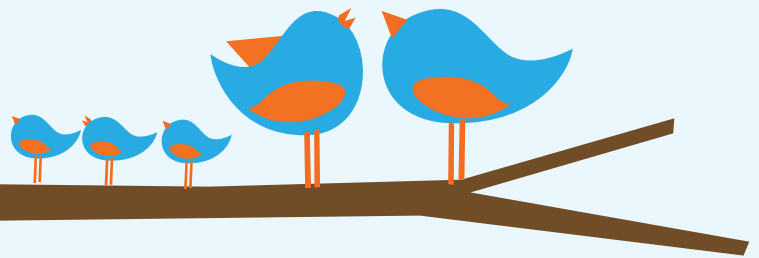


Bird Feeders



Let's recycle! Birds are always looking for a tasty treat. Instead of throwing away those old paper towel rolls, help out your feathered friends!

What you'll need:

- An empty/used paper towel roll
- Peanut butter (or Crisco for those with peanut allergies)
- A spoon
- Wild bird seed of choice
- A plate or bowl
- String, twine, or ribbon

Directions:

Pour enough bird seed in a plate or bowl to cover the bottom. Then, using the spoon, put a layer of peanut butter or Crisco on the roll. After you have layered the roll, place it in the plate with the wild bird seed. Either roll it through the seed, or use the spoon (or your hands if you want to get a little messy) to completely coat the now sticky roll with yummy treats for the birds. After the roll is covered, run some string through the opening and tie a knot in it to loop around a branch. The only thing left to do is to hang up your bird feeder and watch for new visitors. Just be sure to not hang the feeder too close to a window so the birds don't accidentally run into the glass.
